EMERGENCY PERSONAL SURVIVAL KIT

Beacon Christian School

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The possibility of a large earthquake, volcanic eruption, power outage due to a storm, or other disaster in the State of Idaho makes it wise to be prepared!

If an earthquake or other disaster were to occur during the school day, the possibility exists that your child(ren) would need to remain at school for up to 72 hours.

We are requesting that you provide the selected items listed below for each of your school-age children. Please put them in a one gallon Ziploc Storage Bag with your child's name and grade level written on the outside. This Personal Survival Kit will be stored in your child's classroom, or in a nearby storage area if this is not possible.

The items listed below are suggested for the Personal Survival Kit:

- (2) 8 oz. juices (canned) or boxed) with pop tops
- (2) 4 oz. cans of fruit with pop-tops OR (2) dried fruit packages (snack size)
- (2) peanut butter or cheese & cracker type snack packages OR (2) Granola bars
- (2) plastic spoons or forks, wrapped in napkins
- (2) individual wrapped moist towelettes

It would be wise to check expiration dates on all foodstuffs for the longest shelf life. At the end of the school year, we will return the Personal Survival Kit to you and renew the kit each Fall thereafter.

Please stick to the above listed items. Our limited storage area prohibits anything larger than that which will fit in the Ziploc Storage Bag provided. Attention to your child's specific allergies should be considered. If your child requires daily medication, please contact the school office personally to arrange a method of having medication available in the event of such an emergency.

Students should bring their Survival Kit with them on the first day of school.

We will appreciate your attention to this request. Please send your child's Personal Survival Kit to school as soon as possible. The school reserves the right to order a different, but similar type of survival kit for any student that has not brought one by the end of the second week of school, and will bill the parents for the cost of the kits ordered.
